

# Refuge of Light; 501(C)3 Non-Profit

**Isaiah 4:6** It will be a shelter and shade from the heat of the day, and a **refuge** and hiding place from the storm and rain.

The MISSION of Refuge of Light is to provide a safe haven, redemptive rescue and restoration of female victims of domestic minor sex trafficking through advocacy, awareness and holistic care. On average there are 350-400 new teen victims of trafficking each day in the United with the average age being 12-13 years old.

**Redemptive Rescue** is the deliverance from bondage through a response that involves the saving of a life...a life that if left in the hands of a pimp or trafficker has the expectancy of 7 short years. Redemption comes through the life-saving power of Jesus Christ. He is our true REFUGE. –**Psalm 62:7-8** My salvation and my honor depend on God; He is my mighty rock and my **refuge**. 8. Trust in him at all times. O people; pour out your hearts to Him, for God is our **refuge**.

VISION: From the Broken Life to the Brilliant Life: 2 Corinthians 4:6 For God, who said, "Let the light shine out of darkness," made His light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ. Our prayer for these broken lives is transformation into a life of brilliance; that the light of Christ will fill the wounded, dark places of their hearts.

#### Credentials:

Refuge of Light was accepted into a mentorship program with Wellspring Living for Girls in October 2010. ROL was 1 of 2 organizations accepted in the US. A little bit about our mentor: In 2001, Wellspring Living, a 501(c)(3) organization, was formed to help survivors of childhood sexual abuse overcome their broken pasts and move towards hopeful futures. Their mission is to confront the issue of childhood sexual abuse and exploitation through advocacy, education and treatment programs for girls and women. Their programs are a refuge for girls who need a chance to start over.

## **ROL Statement of Faith**

As a Christian ministry, Refuge of Light holds to the following tenets of faith that guide our mission, our practice, our leadership and our volunteers in achieving our goal to provide a safe environment for domestic minor girls who have been victimized through sex trafficking so they may heal and transition into a new life equipped with the skills to allow them a successful future within society.

There is one God expressed as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, who is the Creator of all, and who has sustained creation with his Love, the highest expression of which is the Son, Jesus Christ. Through the saving sacrifice of Jesus, God has redeemed all things, and is sovereign over all. God restores us into a right relationship with Him through our repentance from sin, and confession of faith in Jesus Christ as Savior. The Holy Spirit is God's divine instrument in creation, the inspiration of Holy Scripture. The Holy Spirit is given to all believers as a comforter and counselor.

The Bible is the Holy Scripture, collected and communicated in its writings through the inspiration and preservation of the Holy Spirit, inspiring its proclamation and application through the ages. The Bible reveals the character of God, the sinfulness of humankind, the redeeming work of Jesus Christ, the teachings for Christ's followers, and the hope for eternal redemption. The criterion for interpreting scripture is Jesus Christ.

The Church exists as the model community of redeemed, recovered, revalued individuals who have expressed faith in Jesus Christ alone as the means of salvation from sin and promise of eternal life. The church exists as a local body of believers, and through the ages. The Church is tasked with teaching and equipping Jesus' followers in the new way of living proclaimed by Jesus and His Disciples in the Bible.

Therefore, recognizing God's declaration "it is good," as a statement of value for Creation, we declare God's value for all persons; accepting the fallen state of Creation due to humankind's sin, we confess our own limitations and depend upon God's Grace; and rejoicing in the redeeming, revaluing work of Jesus Christ, we embrace Christ's redemption and extend it to all.

It was Jesus, who in His message at Nazareth, read from the scroll of the prophet Isaiah (Luke 4:18-19): "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." This message becomes our outline for action, and we proclaim good news, freedom, and recovery as individuals and as a ministry.

Is the prostitution, pornography, or sexual performance of US citizens or lawful permanent residents under the age of 18 in the United States. -Shared Hope International, Executive Summary of "The National Report on Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking"

# Indicators or red flags for child sex trafficking victims- US Department of Education

- -student that has unexplained absences from school; truancy
- -chronically runs away from home
- -makes reference to frequent travel to other cities
- -bruises or other physical trauma, withdrawn, depressed or shows signs of fear -tattoos
- -seems to have no control over their schedule
- -is hungry or malnourished
- -inappropriately dressed for the season
- -Shows signs of drug addiction
- -may exhibit sudden change in attire, behavior or material possessions (e.g., has expensive items)
- -makes references to sexual situations beyond age-specific norms
- -has a 'boyfriend' that is older (by 10+ years)
- -promiscuous behavior; uses terminology of the commercial sex industry

# What kinds of kids fall victim?

ANY child is a target for being the victim of DMST but homeless youth/runaways, loners, juvenile delinquents & foster care children are primary targets. Homeless youth are one of the biggest demographics that this criminal activity called 'sex trafficking' targets. Statistics show, within 48-72 hours that a runaway hits the streets, 1 out of 3 are approached by a trafficker. - US Department of Health and Human Services

# Refuge of Light Programs:

- 1)\*Residential Services- ROL safe home (holistic care)
- 2) Brave Girl-Non-residential mentoring classes for high-risk girls in Emergency Shelter & community (advocacy)
- 3) Traffick Signals Training- 4-hour DMST education training (awareness) ROL partnered with Mentoring Minds on the educational brochures printed for this training.
- \*The Refuge safe home is a residential treatment center (RTC) that offers care for trafficked girls that are 10-17 years of age. Once the girls have been safely placed in the care of the Refuge, their new lives begin with on-site counseling, medical assistance, alternative/accredited education, life skills, mentoring and career counseling. Other opportunities include: pet therapy, money management and extra-curricular activities such as, cooking, art, music, photography, sewing and gardening.

- -Refuge has worked with more than 700 'at-risk' youth in our East Texas Communities
- -ROL has provided training to more than 300 potential volunteers concerning domestic minor sex trafficking, raising awareness to over 5000 children and adults in our local communities.
- -Identified trafficked children within our communities and worked with state agencies and legislators to create a system that provides for the rescue and restoration of young victims
- -Opened the *Boutique Tree* resale shop in Palestine to increase awareness about child sex trafficking in East Texas, and help support the Refuge safe home

### CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

Refuge of Light (organization) and Refuge of Light Volunteer desire to enter into a confidentiality agreement with regard to:

#### CONFIDENTIAL OBLIGATIONS

Refuge of Light Safe-Home: Be aware that ROL volunteers will ONLY have knowledge as to the location of the safe-home if/when they are selected to work as a mentor with one of the girls residing at the Refuge. Volunteers will be expected to keep this information confidential. Otherwise, this information will not be disclosed for the purpose of safety to our clients, as well as our volunteers.

Refuge of Light Mentors shall keep their mentee's personal information confidential. All information relating to a mentee's care, treatment or condition constitutes confidential information. Confidential matters involving mentees will not be discussed in areas where they might be overheard by other girls residing at the safe-home or other non-employees or volunteers for Refuge of Light. Mentors are expected to take appropriate steps to ensure this confidentiality.

Refuge of Light requests that ROL volunteers do not engage in public interviews with newspaper, T.V. or radio stations. Contact with the media will be the responsibility of a Refuge of Light Director/s, unless otherwise specified.

All public speaking events scheduled by a 'trained' Refuge of Light volunteer will have to be cleared with the Executive Director before initiating.

A ROL volunteer agrees and acknowledges that the confidential information is of a proprietary and confidential nature. Accordingly, the volunteer agrees that ROL is entitled to, in addition to all other rights and remedies available to it at law or in equity, an injunction restraining the volunteer, from directly or indirectly committing or engaging in any act restricted by this Agreement in relation to the confidential information.

#### **Notices**

In the event that the volunteer is required in a civil, criminal or regulatory proceeding to disclose any part of the confidential information, the volunteer will give Refuge of Light prompt written notice of such request so Refuge of Light may seek an appropriate remedy or alternative to waive the volunteer's compliance with the provisions of this Agreement in regards to the request.

Except, as otherwise provided in this Agreement, the volunteer must keep the confidential information private. Any volunteer who violates the confidentiality requirements set forth in this agreement is subject to immediate termination.

All events are subject to ROL Board approval.

Submission of an *Event Budget* and an *Event Form (a description of activities)* are required for ROL sponsored fundraisers. The submission of an *Event Form*, only, is sufficient for \*third-party (outside of ROL) fundraising events. These forms are available upon request through Refuge of Light.

Our Refuge of Light Residential Treatment Center uses your donations of time, money, and resources to fund the treatment and healing for girls who are survivors of sex trafficking.
